



## Bashore Scout Reservation Daily Campsite Score Sheet



*Each day the Senior Patrol Leader is responsible for scoring his Troop's campsite. This should be done as soon as early in the day as possible. NOTE: If SPL is unavailable, he is responsible to delegate job to someone else. A Commissioner will then visit the site and review the score given by the SPL. If there is a significant change or disagreement in the scoring, the Commissioner will attempt to discuss it with the SPL or adult leader in the site or else make a notation on the back of this form.*

| <b>1. LIVING QUARTERS:</b> Beds are made, Clothing and personal items are stored neatly inside tent or shelter.   | <b>10</b>                |            |            |            |            |            |
| <b>2. TENTS &amp; PLATFORMS:</b> Flaps are uniform throughout campsite, properly secured to outriggers. Exceptions made if tent is damaged and flaps cannot be tied up.             | <b>10</b>                |            |            |            |            |            |
| <b>3. FLAG &amp; GATEWAY:</b> Identificatin of campsite occupants should be obvious. Flag hung properly, gateway construction sturdy & safe, nice overall appearance.               | <b>10</b>                |            |            |            |            |            |
| <b>4. SAFETY:</b> No safety hazards such as low clothelines, unoccupied hammocks, large limbs or rocks on trails. Propane valves closed on all unused appliances.                   | <b>10</b>                |            |            |            |            |            |
| <b>5. HEALTH &amp; SANITATION:</b> Latrine is swept, washstand is clean, toilet lids down, trash in cans w/ closed lids or bags tied closed.  | <b>10</b>                |            |            |            |            |            |
| <b>6. PATROL &amp; TROOP AREAS:</b> General appearance, Fireguard plan / Schedule / Duty Rosters Posted on bulletin board. Area neatly arranged & clean.                            | <b>10</b>                |            |            |            |            |            |
| <b>7. CAMPFIRE RING:</b> Area around fire ring is clear of any combustibles. Firewood neatly stacked. Fire is Dead-Out unless attended. Fire ring is clear of trash. Bucket nearby. | <b>10</b>                |            |            |            |            |            |
| <b>8. TOOLS / AX YARD:</b> Tools are properly stored, if an ax yard is present, is it properly set up and safe. Is an ax yard needed?   | <b>10</b>                |            |            |            |            |            |
| <b>9. KITCHEN AREA / PICNIC TABLES:</b> Dishes washed,rinsed, in drying racks or else properly stored. Chuckbox organized if used. Food properly stored.                            | <b>10</b>                |            |            |            |            |            |
| <b>10. GENERAL APPEARANCE / PUBLIC AREA ASSIGNMENT:</b> What is the overall appearance of the site? Did the troop take care of it's assigned public area?                           | <b>10</b>                |            |            |            |            |            |

*Whenever the inspection criteria pertains to the troop, all patrols within the troop get the same score. When the criteria pertains to the entire campsite, all patrols/troops sharing the site will get the same score.*

*Additionally, scoring can be affected by failing to show up to clean an assigned public area of camp, or by not cleaning up properly after meals in the dining hall. Bonus points may also be awarded to Troops who "go the extra mile" to keep the camp clean. A special award will be presented each week to the troop that maintains the highest standards.*
