- € As with any other outing, there should be a proper adult to youth ratio. Siblings are welcome to attend with their families (please see above note.) Wearing of costumes by youth and adults alike is encouraged!
- € Admission is a donation of \$3 per person (adults and youth alike) to help offset the cost of this event (food, hot chocolate, prizes, etc..) payable at the Welcome Center upon arrival. **PRE-REGISTRATION IS MANDATORY!!**
- € Hiking groups will be sent out on a first-come, first-served basis, starting at 6:30pm until 8:00pm. There will be scary activities, scenes and trick-or-treat snacks.
- € NEW THIS YEAR: Hayrides will be given as an option before or after the hike to alleviate the long lines at the beginning of the trail.
- € Groups that pre-register will be given top priority in the Hayride and Trail Lines. We will do our best to accommodate everyone, however walk-ins may have to wait until there is an opening, and risk not having a snack at the end of the event.
